



**Resolution Adopted by the
Subcommittee of Security
on May 8, 2020**

Environmental Protection Program

*The Subcommittee of Security,
Subject to the approval of the Supreme Committee,
Cognizant of the United Nations' historical efforts to implement international measures intended
to secure the environment for the benefit of humanity,*

*Mindful of the coercive, burdensome, and imposing nature of past international environmental
measures and regulations,*

Emphasizing the need for development-oriented approaches near high-pollution urban areas,

*Convinced that environmentally friendly urban development has the desirable effect of gradu-
ally crowding out existing high-pollution cities,*

1. *Urges* the Aristophilian real estate industry to invest in urban development opportunities compliant with the United Nations environmental agenda;
2. *Recommends* United Nations' member states to:
 - (a) invest in urban development compliant with the United Nations' environmental agenda;
 - (b) subsidize investments in urban development projects which comply with the United Nations' environmental agenda;
3. *Decides* to inform and educate international investors of the economic crowding-out effect in the context of environmentally friendly urban development;
4. *Requests* the Subcommittee of International Relations to promote the Environmental Protection Program to international investors and law-abiding Nations;

Therefore,

The Subcommittee of Security expresses the sincere hope that international investors, law-abiding nations, and other entities, will heed the recommendations of the Environmental Protection Program,

Requests the Supreme Committee to approve this resolution's entry into force.
